<p>Community Updates</p>	<p>“Gravel Pit Park” – The final use of the gravel area along the route of the Light Rail in Milwaukie is uncertain.                  Oak Grove Elementary’s 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary is approaching, and a recognition event is being planned. Members pointed out that this is the new Oak Grove Elementary School, not the old one, which is over 100 years old at this point.
